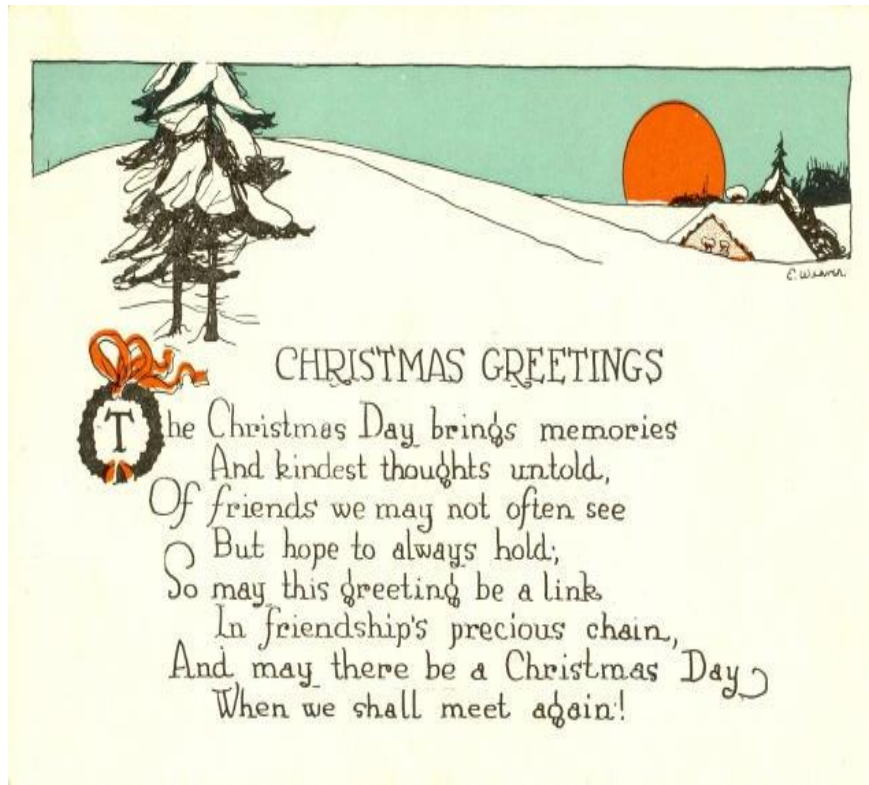
Tractor Club brings Life to Farmer's Market
