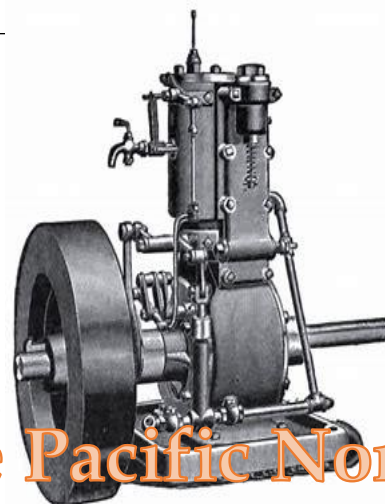


FIG. 104.—THE MARINE ENGINE.

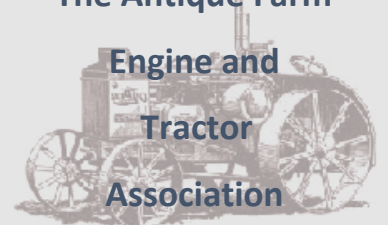
